“Efficient Collection & Processing of Recovered Paper For Achieving Improved Yield and Quality”

India manufactures over 25 million tons of paper annually. Out of this over 80% paper is manufactured with the usage of wastepaper. We are fibre deficient country with no back up of virgin resources like wood through government. Industry has taken up social forestry to meet needs of wood — A SOURCE OF VIRGIN FIBRE. A paper can be recycled for maximum 6 -7 times. Each time it needs to be blend with long fibre or chemical to achieve desired strength. Usage of wastepaper both procured through domestic or imported route brings in the system lots of impurities plastic / debris /unwanted chemicals causing build-up of chlorides in system and lead to odour & productivity issues.

Improving the wastepaper collection system and enhancing the efficient use of recycled paper can have significant environmental and economic benefits.


Improving Wastepaper Collection:

Industry is required to launch public awareness campaigns to educate citizens about the importance of recycling and proper wastepaper disposal. In needs to use various communication channels such as social media, community events, and schools to promote responsible recycling practices. Implementation of a system of rewards or incentives for individuals and households may enhance actively participation in wastepaper collection.

Result shows that Collaboration with local communities, non-governmental organizations (NGOs), and community leaders to organize clean-up drives, workshops, and seminars on waste management and recycling has brought in good results.

There is a need to develop and enhance waste collection infrastructure, including designated collection points, recycling canters, and drop-off locations for paper waste. One may think to Integrate wastepaper collection into existing municipal waste management systems. Provide separate bins or collection days for paper waste to make it more convenient for citizens to recycle.

Partnerships with private companies in the waste management sector to improve waste collection efficiency. They can provide specialized expertise, technology, and resources to optimize collection processes.



Quality Control:

Implement quality checks to ensure that the recycled paper collected is of acceptable quality for further processing. Establish guidelines for permissible levels of contaminants and moisture in recycled paper.

We also need to adopt modern sorting technologies that can automatically separate different types of paper and remove contaminants. We also need to train workers in proper sorting techniques to enhance the quality of recycled paper. To save environment a system which is acceptable to local pollution control board for disposal of waste from wastepaper needs to be implemented on urgent basis.

Recycled Paper Processing:

Optimize the pulping process to maintain the integrity of paper fibers and minimize fiber degradation. Implement advanced pulping technologies that consume less energy and water while producing high-quality pulp. This includes chemical treatment to remove ink, coatings, and other impurities from recycled paper Fibers. Explore eco-friendly and cost-effective chemical solutions to improve the quality of the recycled pulp.

Industry would need to upgrade its equipment to handle recycled paper more efficiently. Monitoring and optimizing paper production processes to minimize waste and energy consumption would help improve efficiency.

Recycled paper is the backbone of paper Industry and would remain so in decades to come. With so much importance of wastepaper for the industry.
