“Manufacturing Various Grades of Paper to Meet Emerging Demand of World Class Packaging

Introduction of the Topic: Globally, the corrugated box industry is a major consumer of paper. The corrugated packaging industry worldwide consumes approximately 120 to 130 million tons of paper annually. This includes both linerboard and fluting media used to produce corrugated boxes.

U.S.A is the largest consumer of corrugated paper, consuming around 40 million tons annually. Followed by China with estimated consumption of 25-30 million tons, Germany @ 11million tons and Japan @9 million tons of paper annually. India consumes around 6-7 million tons of corrugated paper.

These figures illustrate the extensive use of paper in corrugated packaging and highlight the countries with the highest demand for this essential material. The corrugated box industry in India is a significant sector within the country’s packaging industry. Here are some key figures based on recent data:

Growth Trends- The corrugated box industry in India has been experiencing steady growth due to increasing demand from sectors like e-commerce, retail, and FMCG (fast-moving consumer goods). As these sectors expand, the demand for corrugated packaging is expected to rise.

Fluting media paper plays a crucial role in the structure and functionality of corrugated boxes. Here’s a breakdown of its key roles:

- **Structural Support:** The fluting media, which is the wavy layer of paper between the linerboards of a corrugated box, provides essential structural strength. This wavy layer acts like a series of tiny columns that help distribute weight and absorb impacts, thereby increasing the box’s load-carrying capacity and resistance to compression.
- **Cushioning and Protection:** The corrugated structure created by the fluting media provides cushioning and protection for the contents of the box. It helps absorb shocks and vibrations, protecting the items inside from damage during shipping and handling.
- **Lightweight:** The fluting media helps keep the overall weight of the box low while still providing strength. This is beneficial for reducing shipping costs and making the boxes easier to handle.
- **Insulation:** The fluting media can also provide some level of thermal insulation, helping to protect temperature-sensitive goods from temperature fluctuations.
- **Cost-Effectiveness:** By using fluting media, manufacturers can create strong, durable boxes while keeping material costs lower compared to solid board alternatives. The efficient use of paper in the fluting layer helps in maintaining cost-effectiveness.

Overall, fluting media paper is a vital component in the construction of corrugated boxes, contributing to their strength, protection capabilities, and cost-efficiency.



To achieve a good fluting media paper for corrugated boxes should have several key properties to ensure the strength, durability, and effectiveness of the final product. Here are some of the important properties:

- **Strength:** The fluting media should possess high tensile strength and crush resistance. This ensures that the corrugated board can support significant loads without collapsing or deforming.
- **Flexibility:** It should be flexible enough to form the wavy flute structure without breaking or tearing. This flexibility is essential for maintaining the structural integrity of the corrugated board.
- **Durability:** The paper should be durable enough to withstand the rigors of shipping and handling, including exposure to moisture, temperature fluctuations, and mechanical stress.
- **Cushioning Ability:** The fluting media should effectively absorb shocks and vibrations, providing cushioning to protect the contents of the box from damage during transit.
- **Thickness:** The thickness of the fluting media affects the board's strength and performance. Proper thickness should be chosen based on the requirements of the box, such as load capacity and protection need.
- **Moisture Resistance:** Good fluting media paper should have some level of resistance to moisture to prevent weakening or warping in humid conditions.
- **Consistency:** The paper should have uniform properties throughout the sheet to ensure consistent performance in the finished corrugated board.
- **Recyclability:** Given the emphasis on sustainability, fluting media paper should ideally be recyclable, contributing to environmental conservation efforts.

These properties collectively ensure that the corrugated boxes made from high-quality fluting media paper are strong, reliable, and capable of providing adequate protection for a wide range of products during shipping and storage.

To achieve all above properties, industry needs long fibre and quite good percentage, the virgin fibre. Unfortunately, our country is short of long fibre and we are compelled to manufacture such papers with recycled paper either imported or procured locally. Coupled with this are environmental concern where mills are compelled to recirculate maximum quantity of back water which effects the quality of paper and also results in bad odour. Presence of bad odour in paper has damaged our reputation of quality kraft paper immensely.

Since this is SUNRISE sector of paper industry it is essential to address such issues and offer to corrugation industry a product which matches the global standards. Considering the need of the hour IPPTA has chosen to organise seminar on the theme of **“Manufacturing various grades of paper to meet emerging demand of world class packaging”**.

Note -India consumes about 7 million tons of paper by corrugation industry and if we follow above usage pattern as a thumb rule our demand for packaging grade of paper works out to be about 18 million tons.
